## Restore to Me the Joy of Your Salvation — Lent #1 Church by the Sea ~ Madeira Beach, FL February 11, 2024 Dr. Jeffry Iskra

## 1. Cry out for MERCY & FORGIVENESS

Psalm 51:1-3 <sup>(NLT)</sup> Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins. <sup>2</sup> Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin. <sup>3</sup> For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night.

- Our sin is very serious to God (vs. 1-2)
- Admit I am guilty (vs. 3)

## 2. Confess your true <u>SINFUL CONDITION</u>

Vs. 4-6 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just. <sup>5</sup> For I was born a sinner —yes, from the moment my mother conceived me. <sup>6</sup> But you desire honesty from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there.

- Confess that my sin is against God (vs. 4a)
- Confess that God's judgement is just (vs. 4b)
- Confess that I have a depraved, sinful nature (vs. 5)

## 3. Call on the Lord for RESTORATION & RENEWAL

Vs. 7-12 Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. <sup>8</sup> Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me—now let me rejoice. <sup>9</sup> Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt. <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. <sup>11</sup> Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.

- Acknowledge that only God can cleanse me (vs. 7)
- Ask God to restore the joy & relationship with Him (vs. 8-9)
- Ask God to renew my heart & intimacy with Him (vs. 10-12)
