Independence from godly relationships is independence from God himself, because God is present in his Body.

1) Godly relationships connect me to **HEALTH**

Ephesians 4:15b-16 (NLT) ...Christ, who is the head of his body, the church. ¹⁶ He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.
